## A Brief History of the University of Waikato Te Whare Wānanga o Waikato

The University of Waikato had its genesis in 1956, when a small group of visionary individuals began working towards the founding of a university for the people of the South Auckland region. A college, or sub-branch of Auckland University, was established in 1959, and in 1964 the University of Waikato was officially opened by the then Governor-General, Sir Bernard Fergusson (later Lord Ballantrae).

Today the University of Waikato is a modern, forward-looking institution, with a powerful vision and commitment to being the New Zealand University for the 21 st century. This is a far cry from its modest beginnings in 1964 on what was largely farmland, with a handful of temporary buildings and a few staff. The University now employs approximately 1700 academic and administrative staff. Around 3000 papers in 70 subject areas are taught to over 12,000 students annually. The campus covers some 68 hectares, with comprehensive on-site facilities to support the large University community including a range of student accommodation, banks, cafes, sports and recreation facilities, along with extensive teaching and research facilities

The University region includes four of the major tribal confederations - Tainui, Te Arawa, Mataatua and Tairawhiti. From its inception, the University has been at the forefront of initiatives for Māori; working closely with local iwi, particularly Tainui, to make the University accessible to Māori students. The University is proud to be the leading university in the development of partnerships with Māori, and to have the largest number and proportion of Māori students of any New Zealand university today.

Not all initiatives are campus-based. The offering of a range of first year papers in Tauranga in 1998 by the University, and the subsequent establishment of Tauranga University College of the University of Waikato, associated with the Bay of Plenty Polytechnic, demonstrates the University's on-going commitment to meeting the needs of its regional community.

The University has developed a wide range of interdisciplinary and multidisciplinary degree programmes. A number of new degrees have been introduced since 1998 in recognition of the ever-increasing need for education and research in contemporary fields of knowledge.

The University of Waikato has a strong research programme and makes substantial contributions to the social and economic development of local, regional, national and international communities. The value of external research contracts in progress increased from $\$ 1.6$ million in 1986 to $\$ 41$ million in mid 1998. A 1998 assessment of the University's economic impact on the wider Waikato region was estimated at approximately \$500 million per annum.

The University of Waikato is a comparatively 'young' institution, functioning without the support of many generations of alumni and people with long-standing associations with the university. Despite its youth, the University of Waikato can look back with a good deal of satisfaction at its many remarkable accomplishments. It begins the new century with confidence and optimism, secure in the knowledge that the University is well-placed to meet and shape future challenges.

## The University Crest

The motto, Ko Te Tangata, means the People and reflects the University's philosophy that people are central to the institution and its most valued resource. The outside red border is a stylised fern frond or pitau that symbolises new birth, growth, vitality, strength and achievement. Inside the border is the University's coat of arms. The open book surrounded by the four stars of the Southern Cross is a symbol of learning. The crest design is in the University's colours of black, red and gold.

## University Officers' Biographical Notes



## Chancellor

Mrs Caroline Bennett BSc Otago BEd DipEd MEdAdmin Massey

Appointed in 1998 as the Chancellor of the University of Waikato, Mrs Caroline Bennett has had a long association with education. After gaining her BSc at Otago University, she went on to earn her Diploma of Education, Bachelor of Education and Master of Education Administration at Massey University. Mrs Bennett has taught for a decade at Fairfield College, serving as Deputy Principal from 1989 to 1995, and Principal from 1996 to the present day. Her official association with Waikato University began in 1991 when she served as a member of the University Council, representing the Board of Trustees of Secondary Schools in the catchment area of Waikato University. Mrs Bennett was appointed Pro Chancellor in 1992, a position she held for six years before becoming Chancellor in 1998. In recognition of her educational achievements, Mrs Bennett was appointed Dame Jean Herbison Fellow in 1992, and Honorary Fellow of the New Zealand Educational Administration Society in 1996.


Pro Chancellor
Mr John Gallagher CNZM, O.St.J, JP

As a business leader John Gallagher brings a wealth of business and community experience to the University Council. He is a shareholder and director of one of New Zealand's most successful export companies, the Gallagher Group. As an ardent supporter of growth and development in the community, John is actively involved with numerous community organisations including Habitat for Humanity, Rotary and St John's Ambulance. He served as the Deputy Mayor of Hamilton city from 1997 to 1998 and twelve years as a city councillor. As a local body politician he has been instrumental in promoting and driving many of the city facilities and services. John was first elected to the University Council in 1990 as the representative of the Employers' Association and is currently a member of the Finance Committee and a Trustee of the University of Waikato Foundation.


## Vice-Chancellor

Professor Bryan Gould BA LLM Auckland BCL MA Oxford

It has been a long and winding road for the Hawera-born Bryan Charles Gould, one that has led him from Auckland and Victoria Universities, through to Oxford University on a Rhodes Scholarship, then to the British Labour Party, Member of Parliament, director of the Labour general election campaign in 1987, and ultimately back to New Zealand, where he currently holds the position of Vice-Chancellor at the University of Waikato. After attending primary and secondary schools in Hawera, Palmerston North, Tauranga and Dannevirke, Professor Gould went on to take a double BA/LLB at Auckland and Victoria Universities, majoring in history for his Bachelor of Arts. In 1962 he took up a Rhodes Scholarship to Balliol College, Oxford, taking out his BCL(Oxon) with First Class Honours in 1964, and finally his MA in 1968. During this time he worked for the British Foreign Office, including some time as second secretary at the British Embassy in Brussels. Following a period as a Tutor and Fellow in Law at Worcester College, Oxford, Professor Gould entered politics in 1974, working for three years as the Parliamentary Private Secretary to the Rt. Hon. Peter Shore MP. A stint as a reporter and presenter on a Thames Television nationally networked current affairs show followed from 1979 to 1983, before entering politics again. This involved some ten years in the British Labour Party in various roles, including Shadow Trade and Industry Secretary, Shadow Environment Secretary and the Labour Party election campaign director for both the Euro-Elections in 1989 and General Elections in 1987 and 1992. Professor Gould has been the author of numerous publications, including Socialism and Freedom, A Future for Socialism, and the autobiographical Goodbye to All That in 1995. As a former university representative in various sports, Professor Gould retains an interest in tennis and swimming, as well as cooking, wine, gardening, music and New Zealand history.


Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Research)
Professor R Bedford BA MA Auckland PhD Australian National University, Canberra

Professor Richard Bedford is currently Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Research) at the University of Waikato where he has been Professor of Geography since 1989. In 2000 and 2001 he was Director of the University's satellite campus in Tauranga. He has undergraduate and graduate degrees from the University of Auckland and his PhD was completed in 1971 in the Research School of Pacific Studies at the Australian National University. He is a specialist in migration studies and since the mid-1960s has been researching processes of population movement in the Asia-Pacific region. During the 1980s Professor Bedford was the Convenor of the Population Monitoring Group of the former New Zealand Planning Council. In 1990 he was awarded the NZ 1990 Medal for services of New Zealand. In 2000 he was elected to Fellowship of the Royal Society of New Zealand. He is a member of the New Zealand National Commission for UNESCO, and Chair of the Commission's Social Sciences Sub-Commission. He is also the New Zealand Immigration Service's representative on an inter-governmental International Metropolis Project, and the Royal Society of New Zealand's contact point with the International Human Dimensions of Global Environmental Change Programme. In 2001 he was appointed by the Minister of Immigration as academic adviser to the Ministerial Advisory Group on Immigration.


Acting Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Academic)
Professor Peggy G Koopman-Boyden CNZM MA DipEd Massey

The Dean of the School of Social Sciences since 1995, Professor KoopmanBoyden was appointed the Dean of Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences from 1999. Previously she was the CEO for the New Zealand Institute of Social Research and Development, and lectured at the University of Canterbury. She was also the co-founder and Director of the Southern Cross Language Institute in Christchurch. Professor Peggy Koopman-Boyden has undertaken sociological, demographic and policy research on ageing, and has chaired or has been a member of many national committees on social policy, family, women, the elderly and complementary and alternative health. These include the New Zealand Planning Council, National Council on HIV/AIDS, and the Gerontology Association. She is a Life Member of Age Concern (Canterbury) and was awarded a CNZM (Companion of the NZ Order of Merit) for services to the elderly.


## Acting Dean of Arts and Social Sciences

Associate Professor Bill Temple BSc MSc PhD Auckland

Associate Professor Bill Temple continues as Acting Dean of the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences from April 2001. Previously he has served at the University as a teaching member of the Department of Psychology and also as an Associate Dean of the Faculty. His research interests have mainly been involved with farm animal behaviour and more recently, the assessment of animal abilities and animal welfare.


Dean of Computing and Mathematical Sciences
Professor lan Graham BSc (Hons)London PhD Cambridge CEng MBCS

Professor lan Graham took up his position of Dean of Computing and Mathematical Sciences in 1990, the same year as the School moved into the new, purpose-built premises in G Block. Prior to his appointment as Dean, Professor Graham held the position of Chair of the Computer Science Department. After gaining his first degree at Queen Mary College, London, Professor Graham went on to take his doctorate at Cambridge University, where he was part of the Radio Astronomy group. Following a period of three years in Germany, where he studied Archaeological Science, Professor Graham returned to London where he taught quantitative methods to archaeologists. Professor Graham is currently involved in a project which involves measuring the performance of communications networks, the findings of which will benefit Internet and other communication consumers in New Zealand and around the world.


## Principal and Dean of Education

Professor Noeline Alcorn BA Victoria MA Canterbury PhD California DipEd Massey DipT FNZEAS

Professor Noeline Alcorn taught in New Zealand secondary schools for some years before undertaking her doctoral study at the University of California. She held lecturing and management positions at Auckland Teachers' College and was the Director of the Centre for Continuing Education at the University of Auckland before taking up her current position as Principal and Dean at the School of Education. Professor Alcorn was Chairperson of the New Zealand Council for Educational Research from 1988 until 1993, and was awarded the Suffrage Medal in 1993. She is a Fellow of the New Zealand Educational Administration Society. Professor Alcorn has published widely in children's literature, school principalship and action research, and is currently researching educational administration, professional development and higher education policy. She recently completed a biography of C.E. Beeby. She is the inaugural chair of the Teacher Education of Forum Aotearoa New Zealand.


## Acting Dean of Law

Associate Professor B J Barton BA, LLB(Hons) Auckland LLM British Colombia Barry Barton graduated from the University of Auckland with a BA (Geography) and LLB (Hons), practised in law in Auckland for some years. At the University of British Colombia, Barry completed a Masters degree and undertook research at Westwater Research Centre. His research interests lie in the fields of natural resources law and environmental law. He studied, worked and taught in Canada for eleven years and continues to have a strong interest in Canadian law. He wrote the text Canadian Law of Mining and has also authored several other books. He is interested in the relationship between private and public law in natural resources and is presently working on international energy regulation and New Zealand resource mangement.


## Dean of Management

Professor Michael Pratt BA Sheffield MCom Witwatersrand DCom South Africa ACA FCA

A specialist in the areas of performance, organization theory and auditing, Professor Michael Pratt joined the University of Waikato in 1990 as Dean of the Waikato Management School. He was previously Professor and Head of Department of Accounting at Massey University. With extensive industry experience, Professor Pratt is currently involved in researching peak performing organisations. He has published eight books and more than one hundred journal and conference papers. He advises the CEOs and top management teams of several leading global corporations in the USA and Europe on inspiration, peak performance, and value creation.


Acting Dean of Māori and Pacific Development
Associate Professor H Melbourne BA Auckland MA, HonDoc Waikato

Hirini is of Tūhoe and Kahungunu tribal origins. He was born and raised in Ruatoki and holds a BA from the University of Auckland, an MA from the University of Waikato and has just been awarded an Honorary Doctorate from the University of Waikato. His interests are tribal research in land confiscations of the Tūhoe people, portrayal of Māori in children's literature, examining traditional literary styles in the composition of songs and story telling, and researching the making, playing and cultural usages of traditional Māori instruments.


## Dean of Science and Technology

Professor Richard Price BSc (Hons) Australian National University PhD Otago

Professor Richard Price joined the University of Waikato in 1998 as the new Dean of the School of Science and Technology. Formerly an Associate Professor in Geology at La Trobe University, Professor Price gained his bachelors degree in geology from Australian National University, and was awarded his doctorate from Otago University in 1974. His major research interests include the application of trace element, major element and isotope geochemistry to geological problems throughout Australia, New Zealand and the Pacific. With a distinguished academic and publishing record to his credit, Professor Price is currently involved in a co-operative research project with academic colleagues from Auckland, Victoria and Massey Universities, studying the geology of Mounts Ruapehu and Taranaki.

## Ceremonial Traditions

Elements of university graduation ceremonies have evolved from the $12^{\text {th }}$ century when the first universities emerged in Europe. The organisation of medieval universities was modelled on the established institutions of the day - the church, the monastery, and the guild.

Latin was the language used by medieval scholars, and it is from Latin that the words 'university' and 'degree' are derived. The Latin term universitas means a guild or union and universities started as a scholastic guild - a self-constituted community of teachers and scholars.

The word graduate comes from the Latin word gradus, which means step. Admission to study a bachelors degree was the first step taken towards completing a university education. The second step was to become a "master". Masters were Master of Arts graduates whose degrees licensed them to teach. The Chancellor, an officer of the cathedral, originally granted teaching licences.

## Ceremonial Robes

In the Middle Ages the corporate existence of universities was recognised and sanctioned by civil or ecclesiastical authority. The regalia worn by graduates and university staff today reflect this mix of medieval governance. Robes worn by the Chancellor resemble those worn by the Lord Chancellor of England. Graduates and academic staff wear gowns similar to the dress of medieval clergy. Hoods are also fashioned on an everyday medieval garment, although the coloured lining was a later addition to indicate the wearer's university and degree.


The academic gowns and hoods worn by graduates and University staff today are fashioned on everyday medieval garments.

## University of Waikato Academic Dress

Academic regalia are as follows:

First Bachelors: Black gown; black hood with gold lining; black mortarboard.

Bachelors with Honours: Black gown; black hood with gold lining and gold border 5 cm in width; black mortarboard.

Masters: Black gown; gold hood with gold lining; black mortarboard.

MPhil: Black gown; crimson hood with crimson lining; black mortarboard.

PhD: Maroon gown; crimson hood with crimson lining; black Tudor bonnet.

DLit, DSc: Crimson gown; crimson hood with crimson lining; black Tudor bonnet with gold cord and tassel.

HonD: Crimson gown; gold hood with gold lining; black Tudor bonnet with gold cord and tassel.

Chancellor and Vice-Chancellor: Black gown with lining of gold satin; gold button and cord just above the sleeves which are also lined with gold satin; a replica of the University's coat of arms just above the gold button on the shoulder; black Tudor bonnet with gold cord and tassel.

Pro Chancellor: Black gown with lining of gold satin; gold button and cord just above the sleeves which are lined with black satin; black Tudor bonnet with gold cord and tassel.

Assistant Vice-Chancellor: Black gown with lining of gold satin; gold button and cord just above the sleeves which are lined with black satin; a replica of the University's coat of arms just above the gold button on the shoulder; black Tudor bonnet with gold cord and tassel.
