REGULATIONS

BACKGROUND

This Scholarship was established in 2000 in memory of John Bartlett of Hamilton.

REGULATIONS

1. The Scholarship shall be awarded annually to a school leaver enrolling in the Waikato Management School at the University of Waikato for their first year of full-time study and who is taking at least one paper in Accounting in the year of tenure.
2. The Scholarship shall have a value of up to \$1,500 and will be tenable for one year.
3. The Scholarship shall be awarded on the basis of academic excellence, as evidenced by the applicant's school study record including examination results from the last year at secondary school. Financial need will also be a consideration.
4. The successful applicant must be a New Zealand citizen or permanent resident.
5. Along with a completed application form, applicants are to submit a CV of no more than four A4 pages in length including a detailed record of study at secondary level.
6. The Selection Committee for the scholarship will consist of the Chairperson of the Department of Accounting or nominee and one other member of the Department of Accounting. The short-listing process will be overseen by the Waikato Management School's Associate Dean Academic.
7. The Selection Committee for the Scholarship may refrain from making a recommendation if it finds no candidate of sufficient merit.
8. The Scholarship shall be awarded by the Scholarships Committee on behalf of the Academic Board of the University of Waikato.
9. The Scholarship may be held in conjunction with any other bursary, scholarship or award, unless the conditions of the other award preclude this.
10. The University may from time to time vary these regulations. The holder of a Scholarship shall have the right to appeal to the Academic Board against any decision to terminate the award.
11. The closing date of the Scholarship shall be **31 March** annually. The scholarship will be paid in one lump sum in the year of tenure.
12. The Scholarship may be recognised at a function organised to promote scholarships more widely throughout the University.
