REGULATIONS

BACKGROUND

The Bren Low Memorial Scholarship was established in 1993 by the Bren Low Memorial Trust. It is open to Bachelor of Communication Studies (BCS) students in their second year who are intending to enrol in the third year of their BCS in 2012, or those in their third year who are intending to enrol in the BCS Honours year, and Bachelor of Management Studies (BMS) students in their third year who are intending to enrol in the fourth year of their BMS in 2012, or those in their fourth year who are intending to enrol in the BMS Honours year.

REGULATIONS

1. The purpose of the award is to encourage students to study in the area of public relations.
2. The Bren Low Memorial Scholarship is open to BCS and BMS students who:
 - Are enrolling in a full-time programme in their final year of study towards the Bachelor of Communication Studies or the Bachelor of Management Studies in the next academic year (confirmation of enrolment will need to be supplied by the Academic Services Division, before the scholarship payment is made)
 - Are majoring in Public Relations or Management Communications
 - Have excellent written and verbal communication skills
 - Have shown good overall academic performance
 - Are enrolled in, or have completed, at least two of the following papers: MCOM231, MCOM233, MCOM235, MCOM292, MCOM332, MCOM333 or MCOM392.
3. The Bren Low Memorial Scholarship will be awarded by the Council of the University on the recommendation of a Selection Committee which shall include the Trustees of the Bren Low Memorial Trust, the Associate Dean Undergraduate, and the Chairperson of the Management Communication Department, or their nominees.
4. Applicants should submit an application letter, curriculum vitae, and a 300-word essay. The essay should consist of a response to the question: 'Discuss the role of the PR or Management Communication practitioner at a senior management level in organisations'.
5. The application letter, CV, and essay will be assessed in terms of:
 - The quality of the arguments, creativity, and insight demonstrated in the essay
 - The candidate's demonstrated record in using communication to contribute to the well-being of organisations and/or communities, including evidence in support
 - The quality of presentation of all materials.
6. Short-listed candidates will be asked to attend a short function at which they will be required to speak for three minutes on a specified topic.

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7. The scholarship will be awarded annually. The value of the award is at the discretion of the trustees but may be up to \$4,000.00. The amount will be advertised each year and will be paid in one instalment.
8. The offer of a Scholarship must be accepted by the date indicated in the letter of offer. If any candidate declines a Scholarship, or does not take it up, the Council of the University, on the recommendation of the Selection Panel, may offer the Scholarship to another person. A scholarship shall be taken up in the year for which it is offered. The scholarship may not be held concurrently with any other scholarship.
9. Any exception or variation to these arrangements must be approved by the Selection Committee.
