REGULATIONS FOR THE BRIAN SMITH MEMORIAL ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIP

BACKGROUND

The Brian Smith Memorial Entrance Scholarship was established in 1999 by the Waikato Management School in memory of Professor B. V. Smith, Director of Undergraduate Studies from 1991 to 1998.

The purpose of the award is to provide financial support to a first-year Waikato Management School undergraduate student who is either a New Zealand citizen or a permanent resident of New Zealand.

REGULATIONS

1. The Brian Smith Memorial Entrance Scholarship will be awarded to an intending first year full-time undergraduate Waikato Management School student on the basis of:
 - academic merit and character
 - general all-round achievement and community group involvement
 - financial need
2. The Brian Smith Memorial Entrance Scholarship will be awarded by the Council of the University on the recommendation of a Selection Committee which shall include the Waikato Management School Associate Dean Academic, one Waikato Management School Departmental Chairperson, and the Waikato Management School representative on the University's Scholarships Committee, or their nominees.
3. Applicants should submit an application letter and a curriculum vitae. The application letter and CV should highlight the applicant's suitability in terms of item 1 above. Up to three written referee reports may be included with the application letter.
4. To be eligible to take up a Brian Smith Memorial Entrance Scholarship the candidate must enrol full-time in the first year of study of an undergraduate degree offered through the Waikato Management School.
5. Two scholarships will be awarded annually. The value of each award will be \$1,800 (one thousand, eight hundred dollars).
6. The offer of a Scholarship must be accepted by the date indicated in the letter of offer. If any candidate declines a Scholarship, or does not take it up, the Council of the University, on the recommendation of the Selection Panel, may offer the Scholarship to another person. A scholarship shall be taken up in the year for which it is offered.
7. Any exception or variation to these arrangements must be approved by the Selection Committee.
8. In any year, no scholarships may be awarded if the Selection Committee determines there are insufficient applications of appropriate merit.
9. Applications will close on **31 March 2012**.
