



REGULATIONS FOR 2009

BACKGROUND

This Scholarship was established in 1991 to mark the 25th anniversary of the accession of Te Arikiniui, Dame Te Atairangikaahu, to pay tribute to her leadership of the Māori people and appropriately ensure the further education of the Māori people in the Waikato region, at the University of Waikato.

REGULATIONS

1. The Scholarships shall be known as the Environment Waikato - Dame Te Atairangikaahu Scholarships.
2. The Scholarships shall have a value of up to \$2,000 each and be tenable for 1 year. The value of the scholarships will be reviewed annually.
3. Two Scholarships shall be awarded annually on the basis of academic merit to Māori students who are enrolled on a fulltime basis at undergraduate level in the resource management or environmental fields at the University of Waikato.
4. The Scholarships are open to application by students whose families are resident within Environment Waikato's operational boundaries.
5. Applicants must be New Zealand citizens or permanent residents.
6. Applicants should submit a brief CV of no more than four A4 pages in length and submit a covering letter of application.
7. Short-listed candidates will be required to attend an interview with the selection panel for the Scholarship. Successful candidates may also be offered employment with Environment Waikato over the long vacation following tenure of the award.
8. The selection panel for the scholarship shall comprise representatives from Environment Waikato, a representative of Te Arikiniui, Dame Te Atairangikaahu and a representative of the University of Waikato's Scholarships Committee.
9. The Scholarship shall be paid as a lump sum to the successful applicants at a function organised by Environment Waikato in the year of tenure.
10. The Scholarship may be held with any other bursary, scholarship or award.
11. The Selection Panel may refrain from making a recommendation if it finds no candidate of sufficient merit.
12. In exceptional circumstances the Scholarships may be shared.
13. The Scholarships Committee may terminate a Scholarship at any time and recoup funds disbursed, if it is satisfied that the holder is not following the required programme or is not otherwise complying with the conditions governing the Scholarship. The holder of a Scholarship shall have the right to appeal to the Academic Board against any decision to terminate the award.
14. With the consent of the Sponsor, the University may from time to time vary these regulations.
