REGULATIONS FOR THE KERBY BURSARY FOR GRADUATE MUSIC STUDIES 2011

BACKGROUND

This Bursary, set up in 1997, was established as the result of a \$10,000 gift to the University by the late Melva Elsie Kerby, for a student or students of music in order that they may continue their musical studies.

REGULATIONS

1. The Bursary shall be known as the 'Kerby Bursary for Graduate Music Studies'
2. The Bursary shall be awarded by the Council of the University of Waikato on the recommendation of a Selection Committee which shall include the Chairperson of the Department of Music or nominee, the FASS representative to the Scholarships Committee or nominee and the Chairperson of the Scholarships Committee or nominee.
3. The Bursary shall be tenable in the first instance for one year. Students, however, may apply for the award of the Bursary in a subsequent year. No student shall be permitted to be awarded the Bursary for a period of more than three (3) years.
4. The Bursary shall be awarded to the most meritorious full-time student embarking on a BMus(Hons), MMus, or a BA(Hons) or MA in Music.
5. The Bursary shall be open to applicants who have completed an undergraduate degree in music at any New Zealand University.
6. Applicants must be New Zealand citizens or permanent residents.
7. The Bursary shall be to the value of \$1,000 in each year as provided from the interest of the bequest from the estate of Melva Elsie Kerby (if necessary, at any time, the amount available from interest from the bequest does not amount to \$1,000, it will be topped up to \$1,000 from the Department of Music running grant).
8. Applications for the Bursary shall close with the University of Waikato Scholarships Office on **31 March** annually in each year for the award to be taken up in the current year.
9. The Bursary will be made available to the successful applicant upon completion of enrolment at the University of Waikato for a BMus(Hons) or MMus degree, or for a BA(Hons) or MA degree in Music. No deferrals of taking up the award will be permitted.
