▼ REGULATIONS FOR THE LILI KRAUS PIANO AWARD

BACKGROUND

The Lili Kraus Piano Award was established in 2000 to commemorate the life of Ms Lili Kraus and to assist young people with ability who are studying music.

REGULATIONS

1. The Award shall be known as the Lili Kraus Piano Award
2. The Award is not open to application but shall be awarded annually to a fulltime BMus, BMus(Hons) or MMus student of piano at the University of Waikato who demonstrates outstanding commitment and artistic progress in piano studies.
3. The Award shall be made each year by the Council of the University, on the recommendation of the Selection Panel. The selection panel will consist of a Music Department Piano Tutor, The Chairperson of the Department of Music or nominee and the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences' representative to the Scholarships Committee.
4. The Award shall have a value of up to \$2000 (dependant on available funds) and be tenable for one year.
5. The recipient of the Award will be notified in A Semester and the Award will be paid out in one lump sum.
6. The Award may only be held once and may not be held concurrently with any other music bursary, scholarship or award administered by the University of Waikato.
9. The selection panel may refrain from making an award if it finds no candidate of sufficient merit.
10. In exceptional circumstances the Award may be shared.
11. With the consent of the Chairperson of the Music Department, the University may from time to time vary these regulations.
