REGULATIONS FOR THE MICHAEL CAIGER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP 2009

BACKGROUND

This Memorial Scholarship was established in recognition of the high regard in which academic education was held by Michael Caiger. The Scholarship is targeted at the study of History or International Relations, which were Michael Caiger's passions. The purpose of the Scholarship is to provide financial assistance to students who demonstrate academic potential to further their studies, where this potential might otherwise not be realised due to financial constraints.

REGULATIONS

1. The Scholarship will be known as the Michael Caiger Memorial Scholarship.
2. The Scholarship will have a value of up to \$5,000 and be tenable for one year.
3. The Scholarship will usually be awarded every alternate year. If in no award is made in a particular year, the Selection Panel may at its discretion advertise the award again in the following year
4. The Scholarship will be awarded annually to a full-time student of the University of Waikato who is majoring in History, or Political Science with a focus on International Relations, at second- or third-year, or honours level for the BA or BSocSc degrees, or who is undertaking the Postgraduate Diploma in International Relations and Security Studies.
5. Applicants must be New Zealand citizens or permanent residents.
6. In selecting a recipient, the Selection Panel will take into account academic merit, financial need and the applicant's vision for the field of History or International Relations.
7. Applicants should apply on the official application form by 31 March in the year of tenure. Each applicant must also submit:
 - a) A 500-word statement which outlines their commitment to and vision of History or International Relations as a field of study
 - b) A statement outlining their financial circumstances
 - c) A brief CV of no more than four A4 pages in length.
8. The Selection Panel for the Scholarship will comprise the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences representative to the Scholarships Committee, the Chairperson of the Department of History, the Director of the International Relations and Security Studies programme, and the sponsor or their nominee.
9. Short-listed applicants will be required to attend an interview with the Selection Panel.

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10. The Scholarship will be paid as a lump sum to the successful applicant.
11. The full Scholarship may not usually be held with any other bursary, scholarship or award. Should the successful applicant receive a further scholarship or scholarships tenable in the same year as the Michael Caiger Memorial Scholarship, they are required to refund the equivalent portion of the Michael Caiger Memorial Scholarship in favour of another applicant.
If in any year an applicant is offered a partial Michael Caiger Memorial Scholarship, they are able to hold other awards provided that the total of all awards (including the Michael Caiger Memorial Scholarship) does not equal more than \$5,000.
12. The Selection Panel may refrain from making a recommendation if it finds no candidate of sufficient merit.
13. In exceptional circumstances the Scholarship may be shared.
14. The Scholarships Committee may terminate a Scholarship at any time and recoup funds disbursed, if it is satisfied that the holder is not following the required programme or is not otherwise complying with the conditions governing the Scholarship. The holder of a Scholarship will have the right to appeal to the Academic Board against any decision to terminate the award.
15. With the consent of the Sponsor or their nominee, the University may from time to time vary these regulations.
16. The closing date for application is 31 March 2009.
