



## REGULATIONS FOR THE POLITICAL SCIENCE AND PUBLIC POLICY PROGRAMMES GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIPS

1. Open to Postgraduate Diploma or Honours students who are first enrolling in these degrees in either A semester or B semester 2011, and who are pursuing at least two Level 5 papers in the programme.
2. The award will be confirmed only upon enrolment in either the Postgraduate Diploma or Honours programmes.
3. Students will be considered for the scholarship if they have done their undergraduate major in either Political Science or Public Policy.
4. Students will need a minimum of an A- grade point average for the final grade of the Level 3 papers of their undergraduate major in either Political Science or Public Policy. In the event of there being more than two candidates with equal grades, the final grades for previous papers at Levels 1 and 2 will be taken into consideration.
5. Awards are based on academic merit, but will not normally be held in conjunction with another major scholarship or by employees of the University of Waikato who hold a fixed term or continuing contract.
6. Part-time applicants may apply for a pro-rata amount and may then reapply after 52 weeks (in competition with other applicants) for the remaining amount.
7. Applicants from outside the University of Waikato must supply a full verified copy of their academic transcript.
8. All awards are made at the discretion of the Programme Scholarships Committee.
9. A total of two awards may be awarded; the awards are currently \$2,200 or pro-rata if part time.
