## ▼ REGULATIONS

1. The Award is intended for students enrolling in their first year of a MSc or MSc(Tech) or ME programme commencing in December 2011, March 2012 or July 2012.
2. The Award is intended for new full-time students enrolled in the Faculty of Science and Engineering. Part-time applicants may be awarded on a pro-rata basis, but would receive the Award once only.
3. The Award is a contribution towards the tuition fee component of the MSc/MSc(Tech)/ME degree and involves a transfer of funds from the Faculty of Science and Engineering directly to Academic Services Division. The award will only be confirmed upon enrolment in one of these degrees.
4. The Award will have tenure of one year.
5. Awards are based on academic merit and will be determined on the basis of the candidate's results, normally in the best four level 3 papers offered toward the relevant undergraduate degree. Greatest emphasis will be placed on those papers most relevant to the area of specialisation proposed for the MSc/MSc(Tech)/ME degree. Industry papers are excluded from consideration in all cases.
6. Applicants from outside the University of Waikato must supply a full copy of their academic transcript.
7. All awards are made at the discretion of the Awards Committee comprising the Associate-Dean (Postgraduate) and the chairpersons of each department of the Faculty of Science & Engineering, or their nominee.
8. A total of 15 awards of \$2,000 each are available.
9. Preference may be given to applicants who are not already in receipt of other tuition fee funding.
10. Applications must be submitted to the Scholarship Office by the **20 February 2012**.
