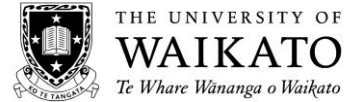

## TE PUA WĀNANGA KI TE AO UNDERGRADUATE EXCELLENCE AWARDS 2012

### BACKGROUND

---

These awards were originally established as the Tau Rua Mano Undergraduate Scholarships in 1999 by the School of Māori and Pacific Development with the first Scholarships awarded for the year 2000. The awards became Te Pua Wānanga ki te Ao Undergraduate Excellence Awards in 2011.

The purpose of the Scholarships is to assist students to undertake full-time study at any level, towards a Bachelors degree in the School of Māori and Pacific Development.

The Scholarships are awarded on the basis of academic merit, personal character, and involvement in cultural, academic, and community life. The value of the Scholarships in 2012 will be up to \$1,000. The maximum tenure of the Scholarships will be one year.

### REGULATIONS

---

1. The awards shall be known as Te Pua Wānanga ki te Ao Undergraduate Excellence Awards.
2. The purpose of the Award is to assist students to undertake full-time study at any level, for a Bachelors degree.
3. The Award is available only to students who will be undertaking their undergraduate study in the School of Māori and Pacific Development at the University of Waikato. The Selection Panel may choose to consider applications from students in conjoint or double degree programmes where the student is clearly taking sufficient papers in the School of Māori and Pacific Development in the year of tenure.
4. Candidates for the award must be New Zealand citizens or permanent residents of New Zealand.
5. The Selection Panel will select successful candidates on the basis of academic merit, personal character and involvement in cultural, academic and community life.
6. The Selection Panel will comprise of the Dean of the School of Māori and Pacific Development, the School of Māori and Pacific Development's representative on the Scholarships Committee and the Chairperson of the Scholarships Committee, or their nominees.
7. The value of the Awards will be up to \$1,000. Up to ten Awards will be made available in 2012. The Awards shall be paid in a single lump sum following the Panel's decision. Payments are normally made in May.
8. The Award may not be held concurrently with any other bursary, scholarship, or award offered by the School of Māori and Pacific Development. If other scholarship success obliges the recipient to relinquish his/her Te Pua Wānanga ki te Ao Undergraduate Excellence Award, the award may still appear on the Academic Record.
9. The maximum tenure of the Awards will be one year. Awards may only be taken up in the year for which they are offered.
10. The offer of an Award must be accepted within a time specified on the formal letter of offer. If the candidate fails to accept the award within the specified time, the offer shall lapse.
11. By accepting an Award, each recipient agrees to participate in any publicity concerning the Awards as arranged by the University of Waikato.
12. The Scholarships Committee may terminate an Award at any time and recoup any funds disbursed if it is not satisfied that the holder is following the required programme or otherwise complying with the conditions governing the Award. The holder of an Award shall have the right to appeal to the Academic Board against any decision to terminate an award.
13. The due date for applications is **31 March** annually.

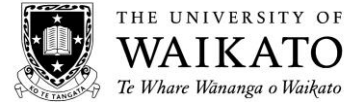
