REGULATIONS FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF WAIKATO RUGBY FEES SCHOLARSHIP

REGULATIONS

1. The Scholarships shall be known as the University of Waikato Rugby Fees Scholarship.
2. The number of Scholarships to be offered shall vary from year to year.
3. All scholarship recipients will be considered by the Waikato Rugby Union as genuine prospects for future Waikato ITM Cup Representative Teams. Recipients of the Scholarship must also be part of the Rugby Union Academy/Development System and / or playing representative rugby for Waikato only during the tenure of the Scholarship.
4. Preference will be given to those applicants who are affiliated or plan to play for the Waikato University Rugby Football Club; however, applications will be looked at on a case by case basis. Each applicant's personal and playing commitments will be taken into consideration.
5. The initial selection criteria will be based on academic merit, sporting potential.
6. Applicants must be citizens or permanent residents of New Zealand.
7. The Scholarships offered will value in range from \$1,500 - \$5,000 and will be tenable initially for one year with a maximum tenure of three years. The Scholarship will be credited in two non-refundable payments directly towards tuition fees during August and December (for A and B Semester papers respectively) of the year in the student is awarded the Scholarship.
8. To receive the fees credits for this paper students are required to pass all papers in the semester which the fees credit is to cover. In special circumstances, students who do not achieve the required academic standard may appeal to the Selection Panel for special consideration.
9. Extension of the tenure of the Scholarships is dependent on satisfactory academic progress as determined by the Selection Panel, and satisfactory sporting achievement as determined by the Waikato Rugby Union. Current recipients of the Scholarship need to re-apply in order to be eligible for an extension of the tenure of the Scholarship. Each recipient however, will be reconsidered on a case by case basis in terms of the selection criteria under points 3 & 4 above.
10. The offer of the Scholarship is subject to the candidate fulfilling all requirements for admission to the University of Waikato (including University Entrance) and enrolling in a full-time programme of study in the year of tenure. **Students must have applied to enrol in their chosen degree at the University of Waikato by the preferred application date, 1 December 2011.**
11. The Selection Panel will comprise a representative from the Scholarships Committee, a representative from the University of Waikato Rugby Football Club, and the High Performance Manager for the Waikato Rugby Union, all acting on behalf of the Academic Board of the University of Waikato.

12. The Selection Panel reserves the right to permanently or temporarily withhold payments of the Scholarship at any time should academic or rugby performance not be satisfactory.
13. The Scholarship may be held with any other bursary, scholarship or award unless the conditions of the other award preclude this.
14. Along with a completed application form, applicants are to include a C.V. (of no more than four A4 pages in length) which highlights the student's eligibility in terms of the selection criteria under point 9 above.
15. Applicants enrolling at the University of Waikato for the first time in the year of tenure are also to include certified copies of the most recent secondary school results which are available, and proof of New Zealand citizenship or permanent residency.
16. The Scholarship may be recognised at an annual function organised to promote scholarships more widely throughout the University.
17. The Selection Panel may refrain from making a recommendation if it finds no candidates of sufficient merit.
18. In exceptional circumstances a Scholarship may be shared.
19. With the consent of the Selection Panel, the University may from time to time vary these regulations.
