

## REGULATIONS FOR THE WAIKATO MBM SCHOLARSHIP

### BACKGROUND

---

This Scholarship has been established by the University of Waikato, Waikato Management School to assist an international participant with living expenses while studying the full-time Master of Business and Management programme (MBM).

### REGULATIONS

---

1. The Waikato MBM Scholarship will be awarded yearly to assist the recipient with living expenses while enrolled in Part Two the Master of Business and Management programme.
2. The scholarship has a total value of NZ\$10,000. \$5,000 will be paid at the commencement of Part Two and the remaining \$5,000 will be paid half way through Part Two of the Master of Business and Management programme.
3. The Scholarship will be paid to one international MBM participant who has achieved the highest GPA at the end of Part One of the programme and enrolled in Part Two of the programme. In the event of two or more participants attaining the same GPA, the scholarship will be divided equally.
4. The successful candidate will be expected to complete the programme and will study full-time. If the recipient does not complete the programme of study they will be liable to refund the scholarship amount.
5. There is no application process for this Scholarship. All international students who apply to enrol for the first time in the full-time MBM will be considered by the Selection Panel.
6. The Scholarship will be awarded on the recommendation of a Selection Panel which will include the Associate Dean Academic, the Associate Dean International, and the Director of Corporate & Executive Education, or their nominees.
7. Candidates must be enrolled as international students and remain as international students for the duration of the programme.
8. Candidates must not be recipients of any other external scholarships for a living allowance. Candidates must complete a declaration confirming that they are not in receipt of another living allowance scholarship.
9. Successful candidates will be advised in writing of the outcome of the Selection Panel's deliberations.
10. The offer of a Scholarship must be accepted by the date indicated in the letter of offer. If any candidate declines the Scholarship or does not take it up, the Selection Panel may offer the Scholarship to another person.
11. A candidate will only be eligible to be formally awarded the Scholarship if he/she enrolls at the University of Waikato in the year of tenure and complies with any other specific requirements of the Scholarship.
12. The Scholarships Committee may terminate a Scholarship at any time and recoup any funds awarded, if it is satisfied that the holder is not following the required programme or is not otherwise complying with the conditions governing the Scholarship. The holder of a Scholarship shall have the right to appeal to the Academic Board against any decision to terminate the award.
13. The University of Waikato may vary these regulations from time to time.
