

WILF AND RUTH MALCOLM POSTGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP

BACKGROUND

This scholarship fund was established with the help of public donations to mark the retirement of Professor Wilf Malcolm as Vice-Chancellor of the University of Waikato on 30 June 1994. The fund is intended to provide substantial support for students enrolled for the degree of Doctor of Philosophy of the University of Waikato.

REGULATIONS

The Wilf and Ruth Malcolm Postgraduate Scholarship shall be offered by the Scholarships Committee on behalf of the Academic Board. The Wilf and Ruth Malcolm Postgraduate Scholarship will be governed by the regulations of the University of Waikato Doctoral Scholarship in all respects except for the following:

1. The value of the Wilf and Ruth Malcolm Postgraduate Scholarship will be same as the University of Waikato Doctoral Scholarship except that the value of the annual stipend will be \$1,000 more than the value of the University of Waikato Doctoral Scholarship.
2. The Wilf and Ruth Malcolm Postgraduate Scholarship is not open to application but will be awarded every three years to the highest GPA ranked applicant for the University of Waikato Doctoral Scholarships.
3. In the year for which the Scholarship is available to be awarded, all applications received for the University of Waikato Doctoral Scholarships will be considered for the Wilf and Ruth Malcolm Postgraduate Scholarship.
