## **POLICY RELATING TO DIRECTED STUDIES ENTRY**

(ratified at a staff meeting on Friday 7 May 1999)

To preserve the original intent of a directed study (viz. to allow students an avenue to study in an area important to their academic programme or career but not covered in existing courses), the Department has developed certain criteria for entry. The policy applies to all students wishing to enrol in any undergraduate or graduate directed studies in the Department of Psychology.

- Any undergraduate student wishing to enrol in a Level 3 directed study may only do so if they are concurrently enrolled in OR have already achieved a pass grade in other Level 3 Psychology papers to the minimum value of 60 points.
- Any undergraduate or graduate student wishing to enrol in a directed study may only do so if the topic is not covered in existing courses.
- In all cases, any student must have obtained the prior consent of a Psychology staff member who is willing to supervise the project.
- Level 3 directed studies may not be used to raise one's grade average for entry into an Honours or Masters programme in Psychology.
- All Level 5 directed studies will be double-marked (this decision was ratified at a psychology staff meeting on 1 April 2005).
