Guidelines:

- 1 The BEP degree consists of 480 points of which at least 360 points must be above 100 level, 240 points above 200 level and 105 points above 300 level.
- 2 Most papers for the BEP are 15 points unless otherwise specified.
- 3 Students must complete all compulsory papers; ENVPL100, ENVPL101, MAORI102, ENVPL200, ENVPL201, ENVPL202, GEOGY209, GEOGY219, ENVPL300, ENVPL301, ENPL302, ENVPL303, ENVPL304, ENVPL401, ENVPL402, ENVPL403, ENVPL404, ENVPL490. Student must also complete one of ARTSC101, ARTSC103, ENSLA103 or ARTSC105.
- 4 A stream (not a major or minor) needs to be completed, with a total of at least 150 points, including 90 points above 100 level and 45 points above 200 level.
- 5 Students are required to check whether papers to be taken towards their streams require prerequisite papers which will need to be completed earlier in their programme of study.
- 6 Students have one elective at 300 level or higher
