

UNIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIP

For students, who in 2020, will be enrolling full-time in the final year of an undergraduate qualification.

Qualifications in this category include the following:

- A Bachelors degree; or
- A Bachelors degree with Honours

POSTGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP

For students, who in 2020, will be enrolled full-time in a postgraduate qualification.

Qualifications in this category include the following:

- A Postgraduate Diploma;
- A Masters Degree; or
- A PhD

Applicants for the scholarships must:

- a) Have a good academic record; and
- b) Be a New Zealand citizen or hold Permanent New Zealand residency; and
- c) Demonstrate good citizenship; and
- d) Show leadership potential; and
- e) Have proven community commitment.

The Scholarships will be awarded without regard to gender, ethnic background, creed or age. Family association with Freemasonry is not a criterion for the award of a scholarship. However, Freemasons have a tradition of caring for their community and will assist those who contribute back to the community.
