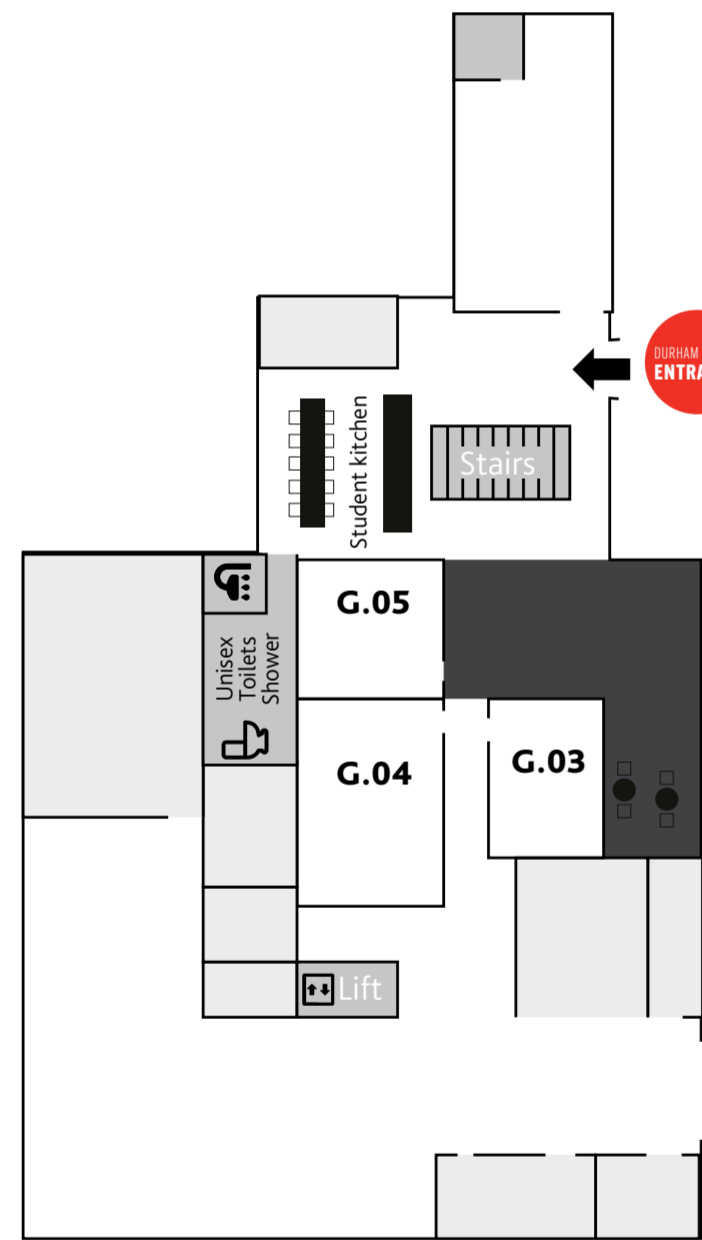


TAURANGA CAMPUS MAP

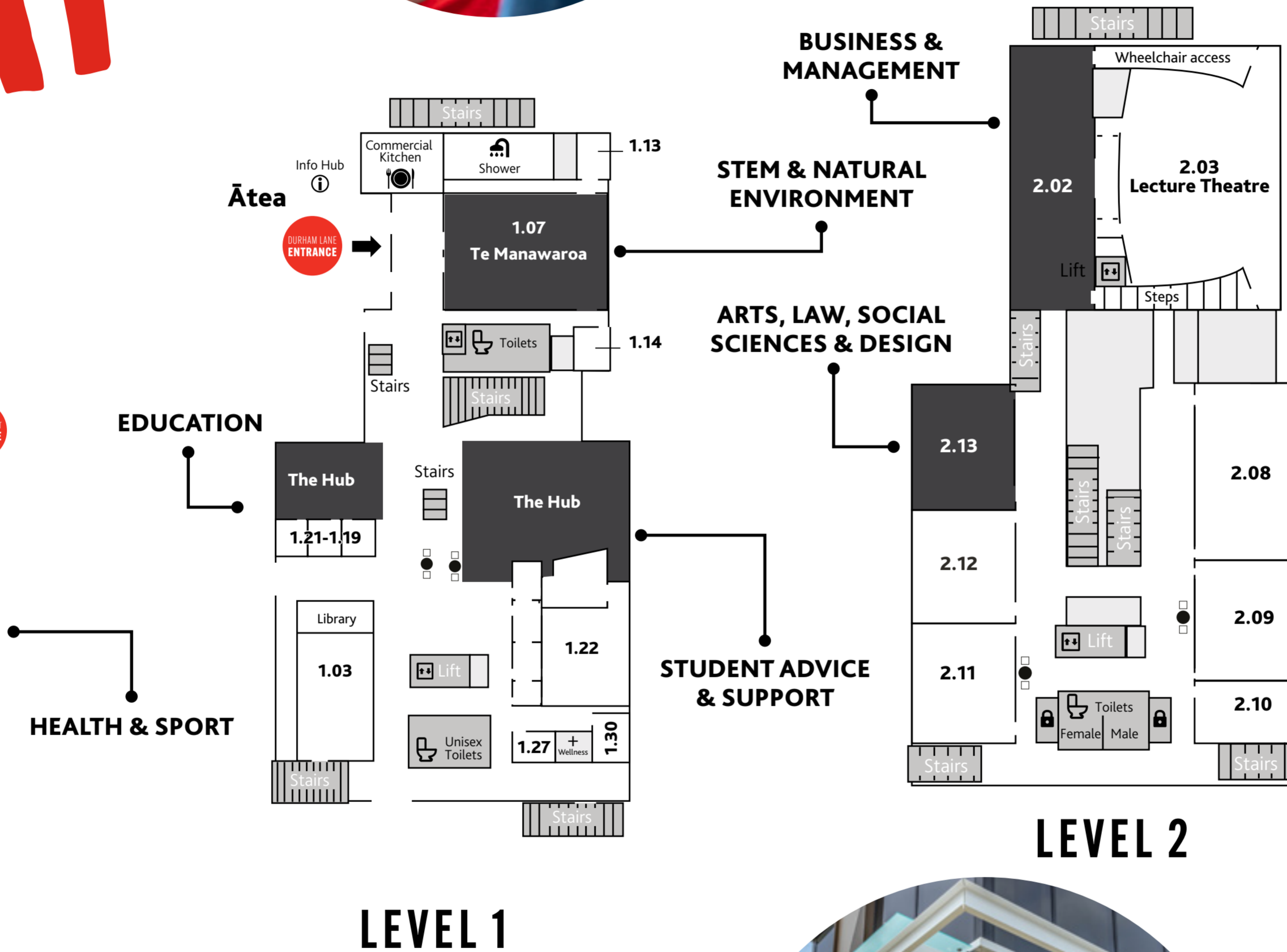


LOOKING FOR SOMETHING?
