
IN-VEHICLE INFORMATION SYSTEMS (IVIS)

We also asked about Intelligent Speed Assistants (ISA)



50% of drivers had access to an ISA

25%

of drivers reported receiving speed related warnings

The number of drivers who use an ISA is roughly the same as those who text/email/ social media while driving.



Drivers believed that ISA's would improve safety

Conclusions

- Drivers use of safety orientated IVIS are low, despite drivers' beliefs that they have safety benefits
- Drivers need further guidance and education on what constitutes a "good " application and what constitutes bad practice (e.g. mobile use)
